RULES AND GUIDELINES FOR EXAMINATION

- 1. Students are supposed to report in proper uniform during examination days else they will not be allowed to appear in the examination.
- 2. Students of classes Prep to VIII are not allowed to wear watches during examinations.
- 3. Students absent in any examination (PT-I/Term-I/PT-II/Term-II) for any reason, will not be re-examined.
- 4. Students suffering from any communicable disease (Measles/Mumps/Chicken pox etc.) are allowed to take the exam in isolation with the prior permission of the Principal.
- 5. Students found absent in examination without a sanctioned leave (by the Principal) will be treated as per school norms.
- 6. Student absent in one or more subjects, will not be entitled to any merit/position/prize
- 7. Student found cheating/copying/using unfair means during examination, will be dealt strictly.
- 8. Final result declared at the end of the academic year, is not subject to any challenge or litigation.
- 9. Students are not allowed to bring chips, chocolates etc. during examination days or otherwise.
- 10. A student whose school dues are pending will not be issued the final result card and will be debarred from promotion to the next class. Parents will be responsible for any such academic loss to their ward due to pendency of school fees/dues.



EXAMINATION SCHEDULE (FOR CLASSES VI-XII)

As per Circular No. Acad-14/2017 of dated 21.03.2017 issued by CBSE, there will be Uniform System of assessment, Examination and Report Card for Class VI-IX from Academic year 2017-18 onwards.

With restoration of Class-X, XII Board examination, the CBSE will issue the report card for class X, XII based on the Board examination with effect from Academic year 2017-18. As the assessment structure and examination pattern for class IX, XI will be similar to that of Class X, XII, the report card for class IX, XI issued by the schools should also be similar to that of class X, XII.



- 5. Students found absent in examination without a sanctioned leave (by the Principal) will be treated as per school norms.

- 7. Student found cheating/copying/using unfair means during examination, will be dealt strictly.
- 8. Final result declared at the end of the academic year, is not subject to any challenge or litigation.
- 9. Students are not allowed to bring chips, chocolates etc. during examination days or otherwise.
- 10. A student whose school dues are pending will not be issued the final result card and will be debarred from promotion to the next class. Parents will be responsible for any such academic loss to their ward due to pendency of school fees/dues.
